





- Engage in continuous improvement! Participate in reviews of education. We recently conducted a JHH Adult Medicine grand rounds review with clinicians
- Make enquiries about how others do it. Email to RACP about CPD collection led to them asking for meeting about improved reporting

Why we do it

We're here to support clinicians in patient care

- Access to this education supports clinicians in patient care
- Literature reflects that library involvement in medical education is highly valued and improves quality of care
- Medical education is a genuinely multidisciplinary opportunity for collaboration with our clinical colleagues, and for them with each other
- HNE Health Libraries' values include being 'committed to equity of access to knowledge and information services for all HNELHD staff wherever they are located'. This service is especially helpful for those at remote HNELHD locations or during busy rotations such as ED and ICU
- Attending education sessions affords us access to a range of HNELHD stakeholders including leaders in medicine, psychiatry, pharmacy, allied health, paediatrics and the John Hunter Hospital Executive – which in turn builds further connections and demonstrates the value of the library service to key decision makers
- Hosting recordings drives website traffic to our/CIAP subscriptions. (Supporting resources are included with most educational packages)

What we don't do

- Develop the programs
- Other admin
- Travel very far – staffing constraints prevent us from turning this into some kind of travelling recording circus

The hard truths

- It's very time consuming (but very rewarding)
- Restructure has increased pressure on staff to do more with less
- It can be hard getting noticed in the busy hospital environment Persistence is key!
I include my manager's manager and many other 'higher ups' in all my promotion of education to ensure they see what we're doing

Take home messages



- Engage with your stakeholders – go out and make friends
- Gather your content – record those clever friends when they're teaching or educating. Find their research papers, link with supporting resources
- Package and publish your content – develop your editing and coding skills
- Make your content available – upload to the library website or intranet site
- Promote access – tell everyone it's there
- Evaluate engagement – use web stats to measure traffic
