



2022

Discover

Survey patrons.

Conduct an inventory of all print items in the collection.

Consolidate
Kingston holdings.

2023

Assess

Develop Special Collection Statements and Plans.

Finalise and implement Collection Development Policy.

2024

Analyse

Generate circulation reports.

Deselect existing print items against Collection Development Policy Criteria.

2025

Monitor

Monitor and maintain collection in line with policies and procedures.


